IVI Vaccinology Fellowship Program: Frequently Asked Questions

Question What is the IVI Vaccinology Fellowship?

Answer IVI Fellowship is a scholarship program which grants financial support to selected researchers from low- and middle-income countries with potential leadership in, and contributions to, public health.

Question What is the benefit of the fellowship program?

Answer IVI will provide the course registration fee, airfare, accommodation, meals, travel insurance and ground transportation for a select number of fellows. In return, fellows are expected to present a poster during the Vaccinology Course.

Question How does IVI select fellows?

Answer An IVI Scientific Committee consisting of IVI researchers will review application forms, recommendation letters, and poster presentation abstracts.

Question What is IVI's selection criteria? Are researchers early in their career qualified for the fellowship?

Answer One of the purposes of the IVI fellowship program is to assist and encourage those with leadership potential relatively early in their career.

The IVI Scientific Committee's selection criteria are educational qualifications, vaccine-related experience, poster presentation abstracts, potential contribution to vaccinology or their institute, recommendations, personal statements, and English proficiency. IVI's selection committee may contact short-listed candidates via Zoom or via Teams.

Ouestion How do I apply?

Question When is the due date for fellowship application?

Answer Fellowship applications must be submitted by June 13, 2022 11:59 PM Korea Standard Time . Fellowship applications will not be accepted after the due date.

Question When will the application result be announced?

Answer Selected applicants will be informed of the result by email during the week of June 20. Due to the large number of applications received, only accepted fellows will receive an email.
